COCONUT OO LONG

Creamy and coconut-y without being overly so. The natural delicate floral character of the baozhong oolong pairs well with the sweet nuttiness of the coconut.

LEMON BLOSSOM OO LONG *Organic*

A flowery, citrusy blend of oolong, jasmine blossoms, lemon myrtle, orange oil, and rose flowers. The floral notes of actual flowers compliment well with the tangy citrus finish.

PLUM ROSE OO LONG *Organic*

A fruity blend of oolong, schizandra berries, rosehips, hibiscus, and plum flavor. Simultaneously tart and sweet with a complex and penetrating aroma.

OO LONG TEA | Taiwan—Seasonal

Taiwan is widely known as the source for the finest rolled oolongs in the world. Taiwanese oolongs run the gamut from very slightly oxidized to heavily oxidized and roasted, and the processing largely determines whether the flavor will be either floral or fruity.

ALI SHAN ZHANG SHU HU SPRING

This years Alishan displays all the characteristics that one should look for in a good Alishan tea; heady floral fragrance and flavor, a nice medium body and sweet lingering finish. A very good value for a high Alishan tea.

AGED CHARCOAL ROASTED OO LONG

A truly rare treat! This tea has been aged for 10 years and then roasted in the traditional methods of charcoal roasting tea masters. The finished tea is satisfying and delicious, showcasing all the complex nuances we love about roasted aged teas.

CONCUBINE (GUI FEI) WINTER

Taiwan. Similar to Oriental Beauty where the leaf hopper bites the leaves but the leaves are less oxidized and are rolled. Ripe fruit, sweet honey. Papaya, nutty and floral finish.

RED OO LONG

The long oxidation of this tea darkens the liquor both in color and flavor, while also enhancing the natural sweetness of the tea.

**LISHAN SPRING**

This tea is provided to us from the same Lishan farmer we have been working with for the last 10 years. His farm is one of the highest elevation farms in Lishan. This batch of tea is his very first harvest and shows with its light floral notes and creamy aftertaste.

**SHAN LIN XI SPRING**

Shan Lin Xi's are always such a special treat in the line up of Taiwanese oolongs. They are a little bit of everything. This high mountain tea has the creaminess of a Jinxuan, the heady floral of an Alishan and the depth & fruitiness of a good Lishan. Apricot, roses and cherries.

**WENSHAN AGED BAOZHONG 1986**

Smooth but with an interesting complexity for such an old tea. There are hints of nuttiness, roast & sweetness. A bit of honey and just enough astringency to help the flavors linger. The Chai Qi (tea energy) effect is immediate. Rivals some of the best-aged puerhs.

**WENSHAN BAOZHONG COMPETITION**

This is a highly satisfying Baozhong. Richer than its' spring version, with a depth that resembles umami in character and a wonderful long lingering of warm floral notes. Not cloying and very well balanced in taste, texture and fragrance.

**DONG DING 1**

Simply named after the mountain region of its origin. This tea displays immense sweetness and fruitiness. Sweet pastries and tropical fruits only just begins to describe what you'll find in this very special tea.

DONG DING 2

The companion to Dong Ding 1, this version demonstrates the effects of heavier roasting. A richer, deeper and earthier experience but the sweet notes of fruitiness are still detectable.

BAI HAO (ORIENTAL BEAUTY)

Exceptionally sweet, this high-grade tea has just the right amount of roast to balance and round it out. The abundance of downy leaves helps bring out the honey and orchid like notes. A highly enjoyable tea.

TWO SISTERS OOLONG

A very special oolong from the Son La region of Vietnam. This tea was lightly roasted to help bring out its distinct fruity flavors and floral aroma. Apricot, plum, and pineapple are some of the notes that we found in this tea.

STAR DEW DROP

This tea comes from the San Lin Xi region of central Taiwan. The teas of that area are known to be floral, sweet and creamy in texture. This tea serves up all of those in spades. Lovers of high mountain oolong will find this one to be a very satisfying tea and it is not to be missed.

PERSIMMON FLOWER DAN CONG

This is a true Dan Cong tea from Chaozhou region of China. This tea is flavorful while offering scents of persimmon flower and plumeria. Drink this slightly cooled to enjoy the same lingering floral notes on the palette.

WHITE PEACH DAN CONG

A truly unique Dan Cong tea, from the ChaoZhou area of Guandong China, this tea grows on tall tea trees and is hand harvested on ladders and then processed by hand as well. The strong sweet white peach is easily detectable and highly enjoyable. A must try for Dan Cong and roasted tea lovers.

GLENBURN MOONSHINE OOLONG

A mid oxidized, unblended tea that is surprisingly floral for a Darjeeling oolong. The taste is subtle but you can't miss the soft and smooth mouthfeel followed by a distinct flowery character, almost like a Jasmine tea.
